\$9,820 Investing For Success funding will supplement an experienced senior teacher's FTE (full time eviqualent) fraction so that students have quality teacher instruction (as well as teaching principal) for 4 days each week. It will also allow for some release time for the principal to undertake coaching and collaborative data analysis with staff.
